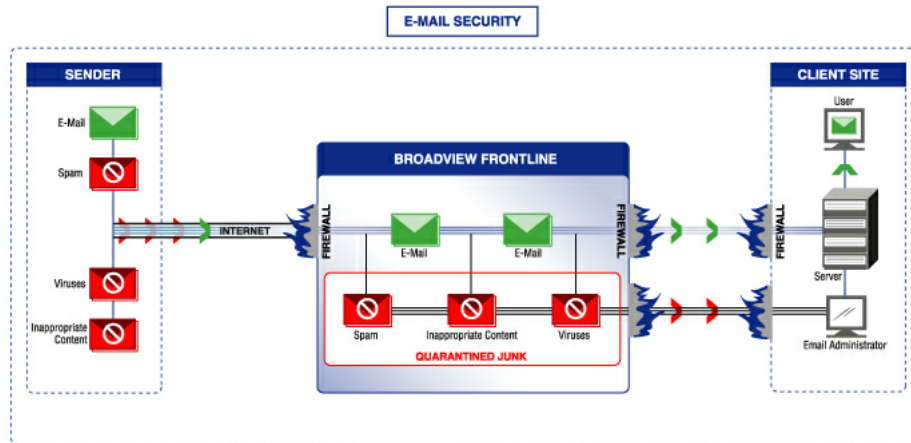

And, while the service is designed to automatically and proactively discover disturbances and identify server malfunctions, administrators can also manually activate Fail-Safe spooling for use during planned e-mail server maintenance.

Regardless of whether a business requires backup protection due to scheduled maintenance or in the event of an unplanned outage, Fail-Safe will automatically engage e-mail spooling when it detects a loss of connectivity to your e-mail server(s), and it provides five rolling days of unlimited storage. Additionally, the service is programmed to automatically provide e-mail notifications – sent to an alternate e-mail address located at another domain – to alert the network administrator when Fail-Safe has been automatically activated following repeated unsuccessful attempts to connect to the specific e-mail server.
